Road Construction Under Way

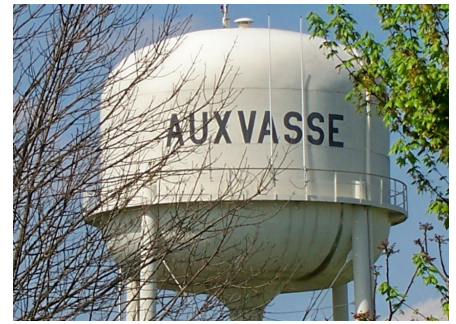
As many of you are already noticing, road projects have begun. Mo-Dot has a project they are working on which includes from Route E to the north end of old Highway 54. This will include a portion of roadway that is owned by the city.

The City of Auxvasse will be contracting with Missouri Petroleum for additional road improvements that will include: Cape Seal from 4-Way to the south end of Auxvasse where maintenance ends. There will be asphalt repair done as well as yellow striping, a solid yellow line and 1 stop bar. Please be prepared and cautious while construction is going on. It is advised to take side streets to prevent disruption to the project when possible.

Ordinances

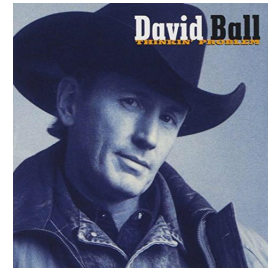

Auxvasse Police Department

The Police Department continues to strive to keep our community safe. They take advantage of all state-wide DWI Saturation Grants that they are approved for. These grants provide funds for over-time hours, allowing the department to patrol our community more often than the city budget allows. Areas of emphasis include alcohol- and/or drug-impaired driving, speeding, safety belt and child safety seat use and inattention or distracted driving. The Statewide DWI enforcement campaigns are designed to reduce fatalities in specific areas in Missouri having been identified with high alcohol-related crashes.

As always, if you suspicion something that makes you feel uncomfortable, please do not hesitate to call the Police Department at 573-386-5555. After four rings it will transfer over to the Callaway County Sheriff's Department.

Ordinances

Don't forget that we do have ordinances in place in regards to trash, grass, animals running at large and property maintenance violations. The council recently passed a trash ordinance that states: the placement of the receptacle shall be placed for collection no sooner than twenty-four (24) hours prior to scheduled pickup and no later than 24 hours after scheduled pickup. Unless the receptacle is positioned for collection during the scheduled time, no receptacle shall be placed within the road right-of-way. Other items are listed in this ordinance that you may want to read about. Feel free to stop in and request a copy of the ordinance.

It's been a hot summer so far so haven't needed to mow a whole lot but make sure you do keep it mowed as needed. There is an ordinance that states it cannot be taller than 10 inches.

We also have a leash law. All pets are to be on a leash unless in a fenced in yard when outside your home.

You are required to purchase a city tag if you own a pet. Help keep your pets safe as well as others. We do have a city animal facility. This is only used when stray pets are picked up. We do not keep animals in the shelter on a regular basis. If we pick up a roaming pet, there will be a pick-up fee and rooming fee. All pets are watered and fed that are put in our shelter.

Auxvasse Fire Department

ALWAYS support your Auxvasse Fire Department. These men and women choose to be volunteers to help save lives. They do not receive income for doing this. We have a great group of volunteers and are proud that they are on the department. They are always needing revenue to help fund their department for upgraded equipment and/uniforms. Help support them when they hold a fundraiser! They will be the ones who show up to your home if there is a fire or if you have a medical emergency.
